Candidate Nomination Package cover sheet – instructions for the nomination package

Form C1 – Candidate Cover Sheet and Checklist Form

Form C2 – **MANDATORY** Nomination Documents (3 pages). Osoyoos candidates require only 2 nominators who are eligible electors of the municipality. Page 3 signature and declaration by Chief Election Officer (or designate) may be done at the Osoyoos Municipal Office, or you may declare in front of your own lawyer or notary.

Form C3 – **MANDATORY** Other Information Provided by Candidate

Form C4 – **MANDATORY only if** you are NOT acting as your own Financial Agent

Form C5 – Appointment of Candidate Official Agent – complete if you wish to appoint an Official Agent

Form C6 – Appointment of Candidate Scrutineer – complete if you wish to appoint Scrutineers

RECOMMENDED – CivicInfo BC Candidate Information Release Authorization, for posting candidate information on websites operated by CivicInfo BC that are the primary source of province-wide information to the media, public, and provincial ministries on election results. Submit form to the Chief Election Officer with your nomination package.
