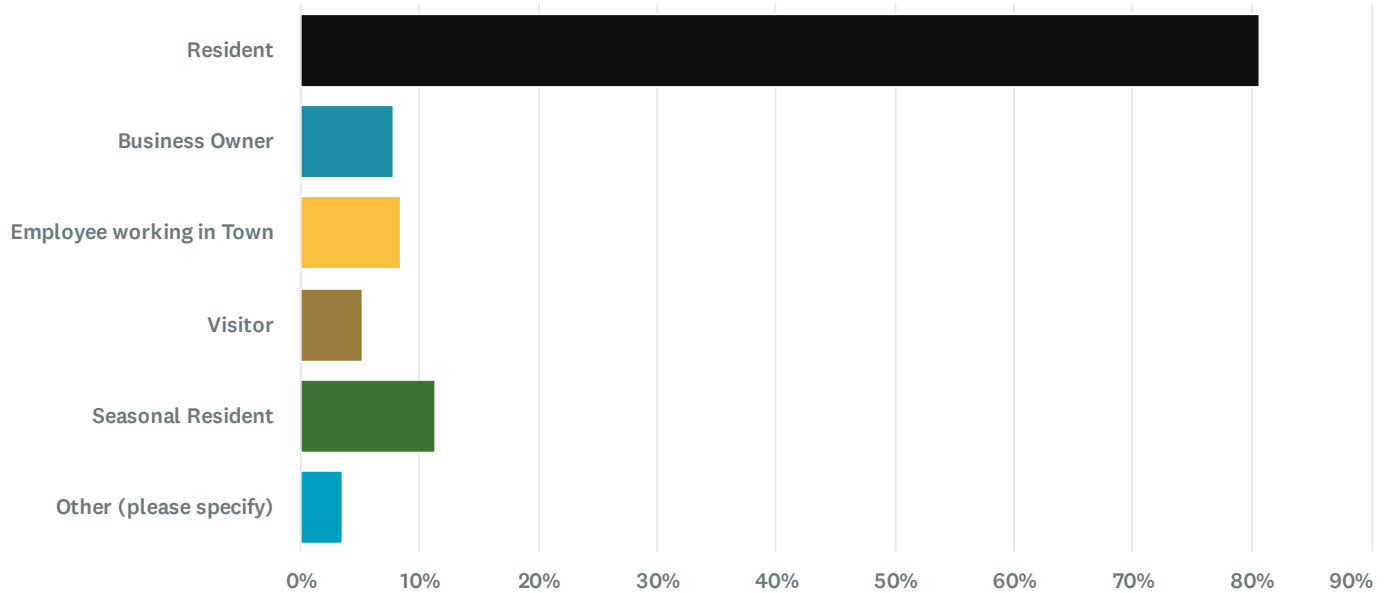

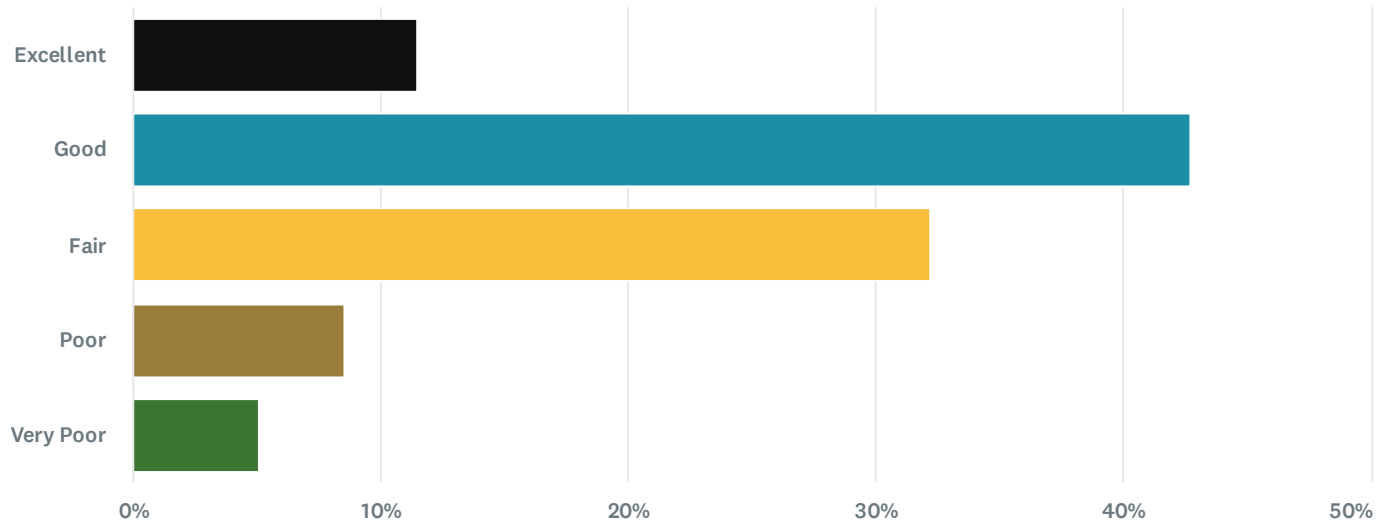

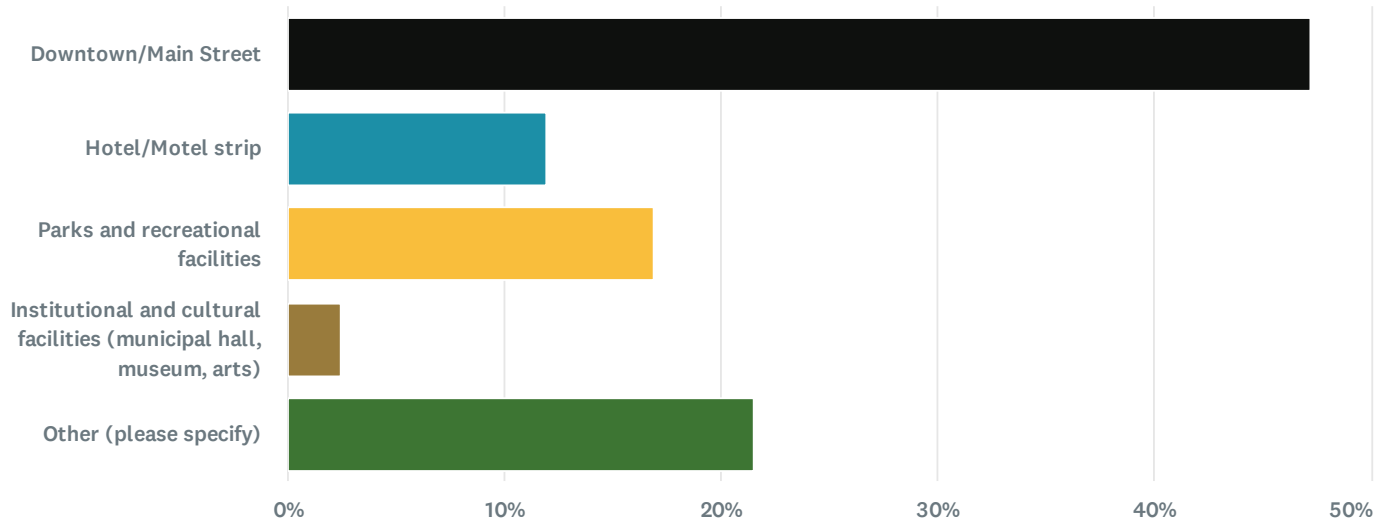
Overall, how would you rate the availability of parking for CARS in Town (questions on boats and RV parking follow below)?

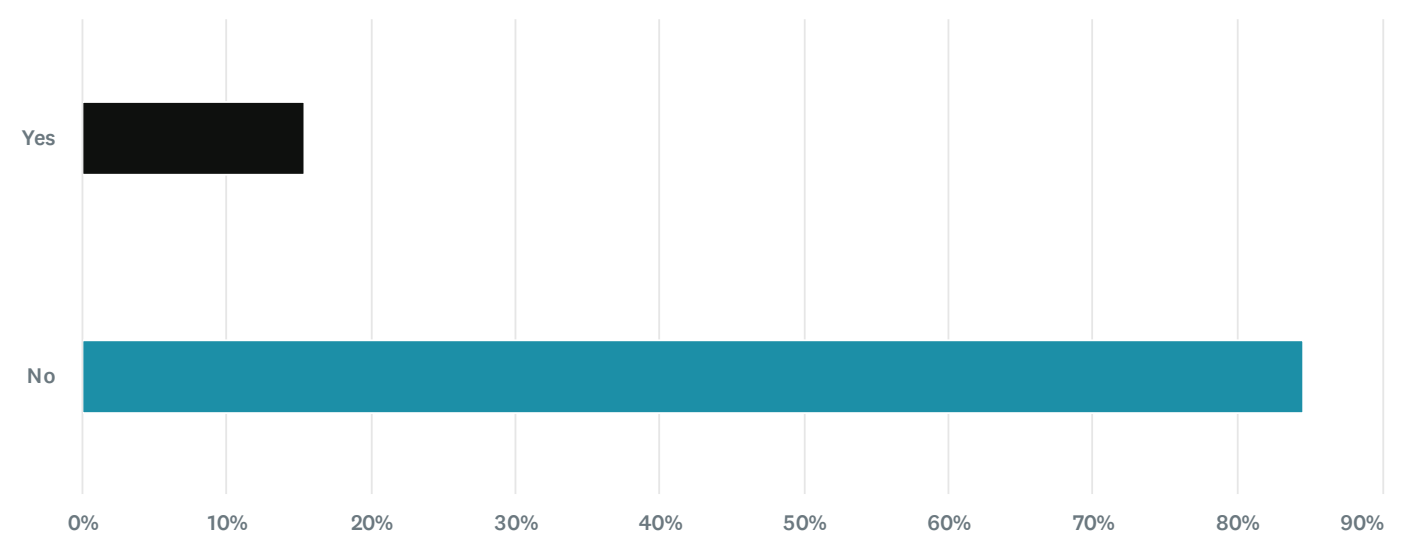

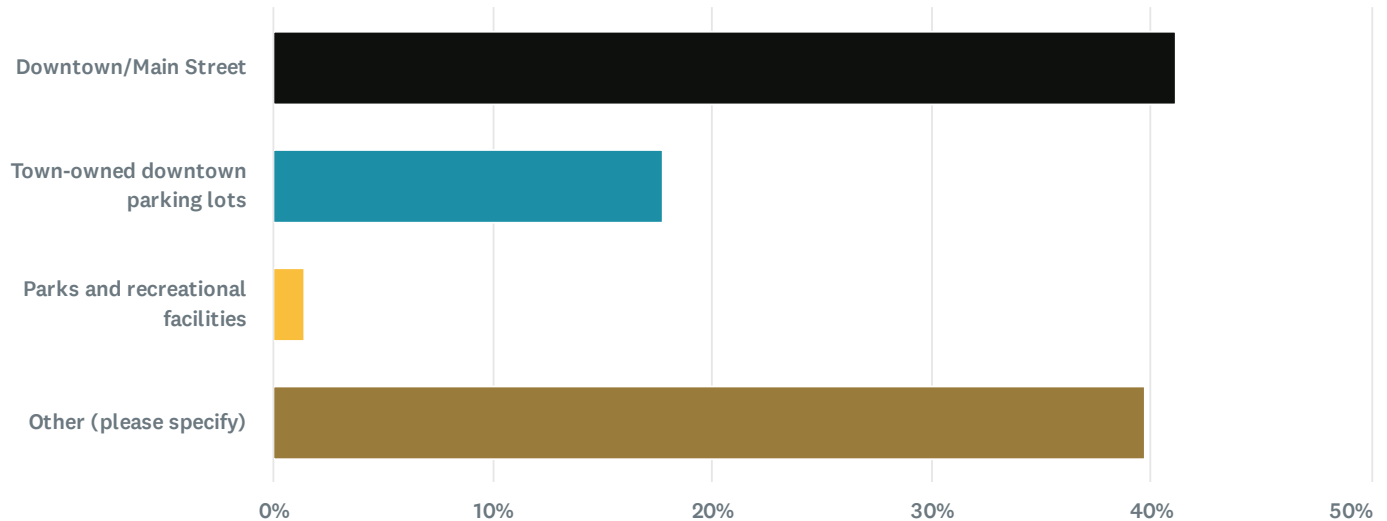
Do you feel some areas should be metered or have pay-parking for cars?

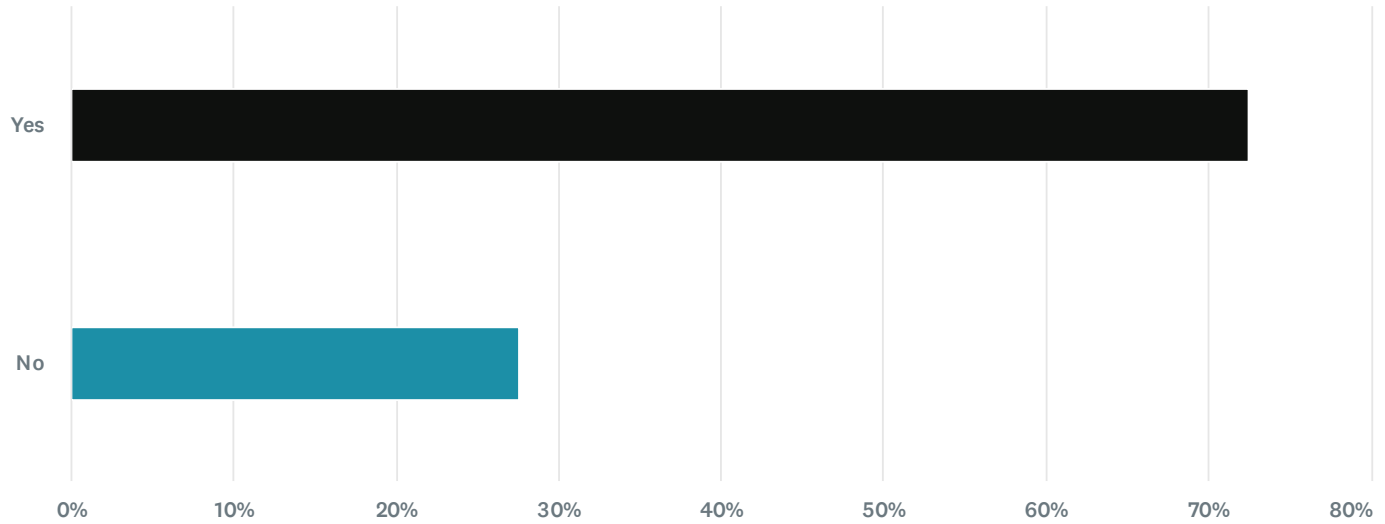

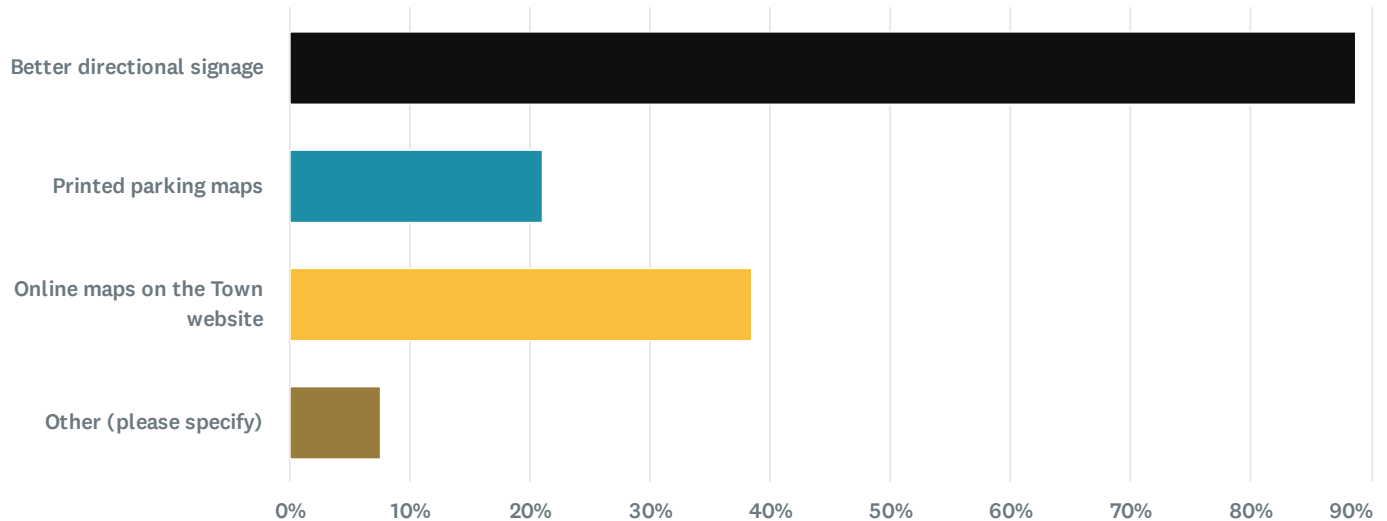
Are you aware there are four Town-owned free parking lots in the downtown area?

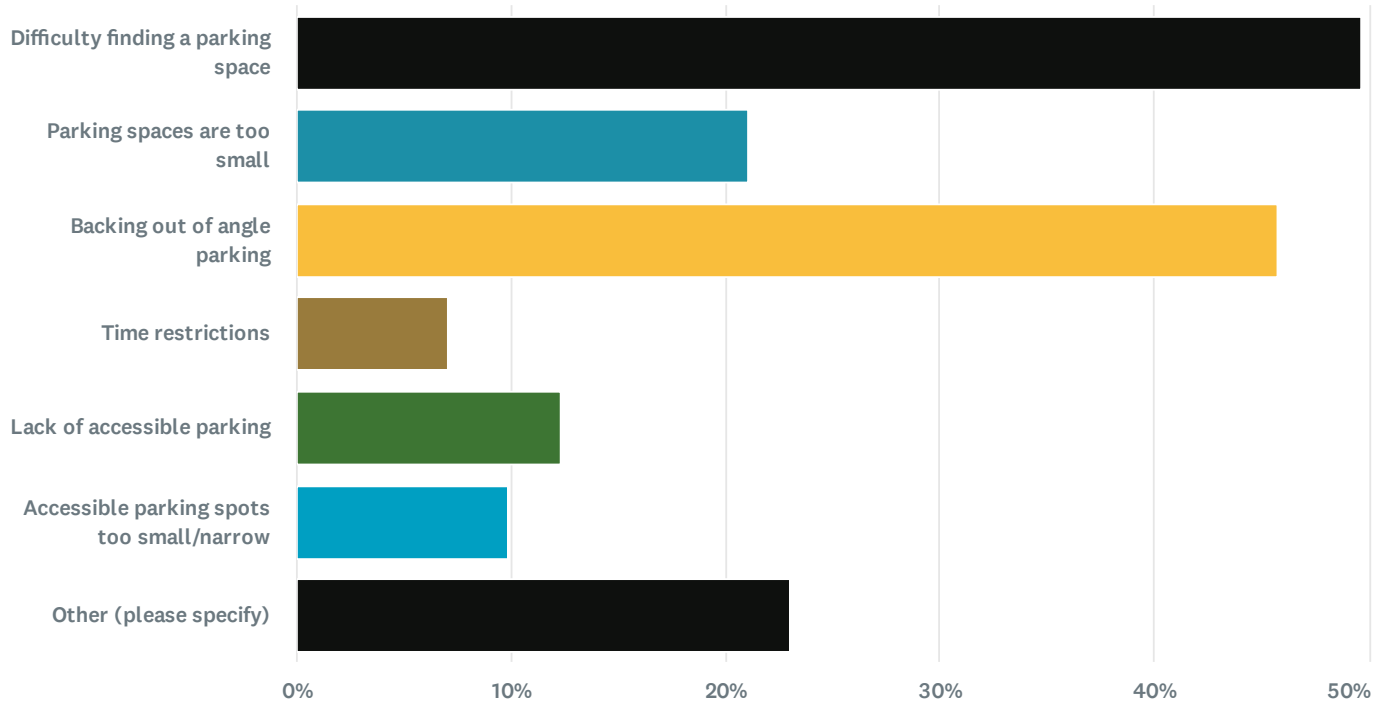

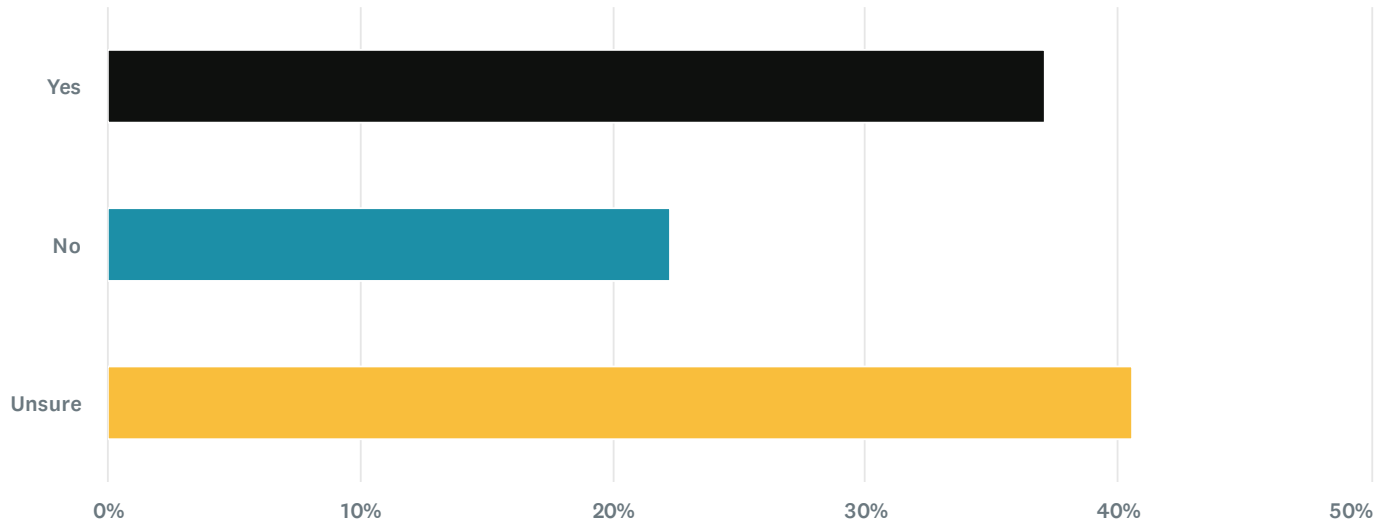
